10. A CD-ROM disk containing the petition, prefiled testimony and exhibits in an electronic format suitable for web posting.



The Town of Lowell, the Lowell Planning Commission and the Northeastern Vermont Development Association were given at least 45 days advance notice of this filing as required by 30 V.S.A. § 248(f). As indicated in its letter, the Town of Lowell Selectboard supports the proposed wind measurement stations and the potential benefits to the community. Concurrently with this filing, GMP has notified adjoining landowners of the Project in compliance with Vermont Public Service Board Rule 5.402(B), based on the certified Lowell grand list, dated July 21, 2009.
